ORDINANCE NO. 175

AN ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMIT ON FRIEDENSTAHL AVENUE (TR 514) BETWEEN TATAMY ROAD (SR 1002) AND FIFTH STREET (TR 580) AT 25 MILES PER HOUR; AND, ESTABLISHING PENN ALLEN ROAD (TR 505) AS A SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE BETWEEN SR 946 AND SR 248.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Nazareth Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to official traffic studies conducted and approved, and enacted and ordained by the authority of same, pursuant to the Second Class Township Code, as amended, and Vehicle Code, as amended, as follows:

SECTION 1.

The speed limitation on Friedenstahl Avenue (TR 514) is hereby set at twenty-five (25) miles per hour between Tatamy Road (SR 1002) and Fifth Street (TR 580) and shall be so posted in accordance with law.

SECTION 2.

Ordinance No. 110 setting forth emergency powers, authority, and procedures in the event of a snow emergency; defining snow emergency; prohibiting the parking and placement of snow on road rights-of-way; granting authority to police setting forth authority to impound vehicles and imposing costs thereon; and, setting forth violations and penalties therefor, is hereby amended to add the following snow emergency route to Section 5(a):

SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES

Penn Allen Road from Route 946 (SR 946) to Route 248 (SR 248)

SECTION 3.

Penalty for violation of the speed limitation provisions set forth above shall be as provided in the Vehicle Code, as amended.

SECTION 4.

All Ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby specifically repealed.

SECTION 5.

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or portion or part of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of Record of competent jurisdiction, then, in that event, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain unaffected and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6.


This Ordinance shall be effective immediately when posted.
